WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU: HOUSEHOLD INCOME GUIDELINES

Proof of Income

- Most Recent 1 Month OR
- Most Recent Federal Income Tax Form
- Include Check Stubs, Award Letters from Social Security, etc.

From the Same Time Period as Above include:

- FIP
- Child Support
- Pension
- OTHER Income Sources

Additional Items to Bring With you:

- Social Security card or Driver's license documentation
- Names, Birth Dates of ALL in Household
- Most Recent Heat Bill
- Most Recent Electric Bill (if separate from Heat Bill)
