2019-2020 IOWA HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

ATTENTION: RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS NEED HELP WITH YOUR HEATING BILL?

The 2019-2020 Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) has been established to help qualifying low-income Iowa homeowners and renters pay for a portion of their primary heating costs for the winter heating season.

The assistance is based on household income, household size, type of fuel, and type of housing.

WHEN TO APPLY:

• **Elderly (60 & over) and/or disabled:**

October 1, 2019 to April 30, 2020

• **All other households:**

November 1, 2019 to April 30, 2020

WHAT TO TAKE:

• **Proof of Income** (for all household members age 19, and over)

Check stubs from the previous 30 days, award letter from Social Security or 2018 tax return

• **Social Security numbers for all household members (documentation required)**

• **Recent heat bill**

• **Recent electric bill**

• **If you receive alimony or child support, it will also need to be verified.**

WAGE EARNERS:

Please bring copies of your check stubs for the 30-day period preceding the date of application, or a copy of your federal income tax return.

FIXED INCOME:

This income may include: Social Security Benefits, Supplemental Security Income, Family Investment Program, Veteran's Assistance, Unemployment Insurance, and pensions. Please bring copies of your check stubs from the previous 30 days.

SELF-EMPLOYED/FARMERS:

Please bring a copy of your most recent federal income tax return.

FIP RECIPIENTS:

Please bring your current DHS Notice of Decision or contact your local office for acceptable document information.
